At the UC Berkeley African Studies Center, she oversees public programs and fellowships, and she works closely with the African languages program. She has been on the editorial boards of Soccer and Society; Sport in Society; and Impumelelo: The Interdisciplinary Journal of Sports in Africa. She has played soccer for most of her life and has coached for over 14 years.
